**PRODUCT DESCRIPTION:** Gasket Sealant Type 3 is a slow drying liquid that changes to a pliable, tacky film through solvent evaporation. It seals close fitting parts, machined surfaces and threaded connections.

Conforms to MIL-S-45180C, Type III.

**WORKS BEST ON:** Threaded connections, metal to metal assemblies, cover plates, flanges, hose connections and close fitting parts. Stays pliable and will not crack. Prime Seal permits easy disassembly and will not corrode metal parts. Use with hard or soft gaskets.

**SURFACE PREPARATION:** Thoroughly clean mating surfaces with a residue-free cleaning solvent and allow to dry.

## **REMOVAL METHODS:**

Before Cure: Clean excess with isopropyl alcohol

After Cure: Cover the sealant with alcohol and allow to soften overnight.

**HELPFUL HINTS:** Once Gasket Sealant #3 is applied, it develops a hard, semi-flexible sealant by solvent evaporation. Dry time will vary with temperature humidity and gap.
